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Dallas' Newest Cajun Seafood Spot Opens with Women Empowerment Celebration New Orleans French Quarter Inspired Sports Bar Adds Cajun Flair to Game Days with Unique Menu, Bourbon Street Décor, and Available Bottle Service

DALLAS (June 10, 2021) – N’awlins Restaurant Group opens their first long awaited concept, delivering **New Orleans culture** to Dallas’ front door step. **N’awlins Seafood Sports Bar** is celebrating its **grand opening** on **June 19, 2021**. The restaurant begins their normal hours that morning at **11am**.

The grand opening ceremony will be a celebration of women empowerment and Freedom Day (Juneteenth) with live music by “Unfaded” and drink specials. The company is **women-led** by General Manager, Ivy Solis and **black-owned**. They are also celebrating its opening after facing multiple setbacks. After changing its location to the **Design District**, an unexpected COVID-19 caused further setbacks this year along with technical hiccups on the soft opening.

“We’re all very excited to finally present the N’awlins vision to the Design District,” shared **Blair Johnson**, owner of N’awlins. “Once you’ve experienced the atmosphere, food, and service you will quickly understand why I chose this concept for my first restaurant venture. I want everyone to feel the hospitality of New Orleans when they are here.”

When the guests enter, they will step foot into a Mardi Gras wonderland. The restaurant features hand painted artistry on the walls and bar tops, Mardi Gras themed décor, sparkling chandeliers, and **25 flat-screen TVs**. N’awlins challenges the traditional take on an average sports bar by including many seafood options. Additionally, the restaurant has a dog-friendly patio seating area for guests to dine outdoors.

The menu features French Quarter staples including:

- Oysters
- Jambalaya
- Crawfish Etouffee
- Gumbo
- Beignets

Vegan and vegetarian options are available as well. The menu was crafted by Johnson, Executive Chef Stefen Briley, and Chef Ryheem Lumpkins. Chef Briley is a seasoned professional with more than 15 years of experience in the culinary business. He strived to provide authentic crescent city classic dishes of his hometown with a large variety of options.

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The cocktail menu features creative craft cocktails like the Bourbon Street Tea, Oak Cliff, and Highland Park Martini just to name a few. Bottles are also available to purchase. The drink menu was created by N'awlins bar manager, Domenique Slaughter. There will be surprise drink specials on draft beers, appetizers, and cocktails on the grand opening date.

N'awlins is still continuing to implement appropriate sanitizing between guest seating.
